NATIONAL POPULATION AND HOUSING CENSUS (NPCH) 2024

The Government of Uganda has organised and released a roadmap for the National Population and Housing Census (NPCH) 2024. All learners in Higher Education Institutions must participate in the census from 10th -20th May 2024. Classes will resume on 21st May 2024.

Effect on Teaching and Learning

The planned teaching and learning for the semester will end on 19th June 2024 and 24th June 2024 for the postgraduate diploma evening and weekend programmes respectively, and on 4th September 2024 and 31st August 2024 for the masters' degree evening and weekend programmes.

To enable Participants involvement in the census, there will be no contact teaching for the number of days as indicated below: -

Actions taken for All programmes (Evening, Week-end)

- (a) all participants shall be given reading materials, and be guided to reading resources to read during the census period (refer to master time table) and consequently cover the topics that are to be missed where a programme is affected
- (b) The Module Leaders in consultation with the Course Managers will ensure that the topics affected are covered and module assessment is made.

- (c) The affected modules for the Postgraduate Diploma weekend programmes is module 5 only, and for the evening programmes modules 5 & 6, while for the Masters degrees modules 1 & 2, year one semester two are affected. The tables below show the actual days per module, where contact teaching will not be done.
